Sensex tad down amid choppy trade; telecom stocks rise

Mumbai, The key Indian equity indices traded on a subdued note on Wednesday morning. The indices were pulled lower by the fall in shares of index-heavyweights Infosys and Tata Consultancy Services. Around 10.30 a.m., Sensex was trading at 58,230.99, lower by 48.49 points or 0.08 per cent from its previous close of 58,279.48. It traded at 58,350.56 and has so far touched an intraday high 58,372.94 and a low of 58,169.36 points. The Nifty50 on the National Stock Exchange was trading at 17,345.45, higher by 16.65 points or 0.1 per cent from its previous close. However, bucking the subdued telecom stocks rose amid hopes of a relief package. The Union Cabinet is expected to discuss relief measures for the stressed sector on Wednesday. Shares of Bharat Airtel on the BSE have touched a 52-week high of Rs 684 per share. Vodafone Idea shares surged 4.7 per cent to Rs 8.67 per share.

India likely to see first woman chief of financial regulator

New Delhi, India may get its first female chief of a financial regulator as the current Independent Director on the Board of Larsen & Toubro Infotech. A 1982 batch Kerala cadre officer of the Indian Administrative Service (IAS), Sundararajan superannuated on July 31, 2019 as Chairman of the Digital Technology Department, Earlier, she served as consultant to the New Development Bank in Shanghai. She also served as the Managing Director & Chief Executive Officer at CIC Securities Private Ltd and as Executive Director on the Board of ICICI Bank.
